

COMPLIANCE AND ANTI-CORRUPTION POLICY

GHESA is committed to strict compliance with national and international legislation as well as international agreements relating to crime prevention, human rights, environmental protection and workers' rights. This commitment is articulated in the following declaration of intent:

- Avert, monitor and prevent corruption-related offences from being committed within or on behalf of GHESA.
- Avert, monitor and prevent any director, manager, employee or collaborator of GHESA from requesting or accepting an unjustified benefit or advantage of any kind, for themselves or for GHESA, as consideration for undue favourable treatment in commercial relations, the contracting of services and/or the acquisition or sale of goods.
- Implement a Code of Ethics setting out the basic principles of conduct of GHESA's
 directors, managers, employees and collaborators. This Code of Ethics shall
 describe the general rules of professional conduct and the manner in which
 relations with customers, suppliers, partners and competitors are to be conducted.
- Implement a crime prevention model, following international best practices. This
 model shall list the crimes susceptible of being committed by managers, directors,
 employees or collaborators of GHESA, as well as the appropriate controls to
 identify and prevent them.
- Include, as part of its crime prevention model, an internal reporting system, with an
 internal reporting channel (whistleblowing channel) and an information
 management procedure, designed to enable any person directly or indirectly linked
 to GHESA to report any wrongdoing of which they are aware and which directly or
 indirectly involves GHESA.
- Guarantee protection and confidentiality for the person reporting any wrongdoing within the framework of GHESA's crime prevention model.
